

Research opportunity: Patients with fatty acid oxidation disorders

A new study looking at the effects of fatty acid oxidation disorders (FAOD) on insulin sensitivity is being conducted at OHSU. Some types of FAODs may protect people from developing diabetes and we wish to explore this with further testing and see if it has implications for people without FAODs. If you have MCAD, VLCAD, LCHAD or TFP deficiency and are 18 years old or older, you may be eligible to participate.

Participants must come to OHSU and stay at the Clinical Research Center for 3 days and two nights on two different occasions about 4 months apart. Travel to OHSU is covered and you may receive up to \$1025 for completing the study.
